

Have you ever found an unexpected \$10 or \$20 in your pocket? There's something joyful about discovering a hidden treasure—an unexpected delight that brings a smile. That's exactly how I felt this week at the Back-to-School Bash. But instead of cash, the treasures I found were far more valuable—gifts of time, talent, and connection. The goal of the event was simple: to create a welcoming space where families could connect, students could celebrate the start of a new school year, and our community could come together in fun. With the help of 25 incredible volunteers, we hosted nine fun-filled activities: games, crafts, bouncy castles, free haircuts, face painting, balloon animals, food, school supplies, and even a prayer table.

As I helped assign volunteers to different areas, I began to notice some hidden talents emerge. Who knew that College Heights had balloon artists with their own air compressor and supplies? Or that local community pastors had a knack for giving sharp, professional haircuts? Even more delightful were the face painters, who cheerfully told every child, "I can

paint anything you want!"—which made it hilariously difficult for the kids to decide. Beyond the activities, moments of connection became meaningful treasures. A Celebrate Recovery attendee, sending her child to CHCS for the first time, found encouragement from other parents. A shy young person found comfort at the prayer table, and the woman from the company that rents out bouncy castles returned with her daughter—her first time personally engaging with our school and church community. These moments, small and significant,

remind us of the richness found in shared experiences.

It was beautiful to see the collaborative spirit between the Lacombe Food Bank, the church, CHCS, PAA, Burman University, and our neighborhood. Thank you, College Heights community! Your generosity, creativity, and spirit of service made this event unforgettable. From preparing delicious food to setting up the gym, playing with kids, crafting cool projects, cleaning, and simply showing up—your contributions made a real impact.
