From the Pastor's heart

As I write this, the sun is just rising here in Hawaii. It's been a blessed time of reconnecting with family, old friends, and meeting new ones. The last time I was here was nearly 30 years ago with my family. Now, walking these familiar paths again through church halls, Waikiki, the swap meet, and the Polynesian Cultural Center, my heart is filled with memories. Some of those who were part of that trip, like my father and brother, are no longer here, and their absence makes the memories even more sacred.

In the Bible, places often hold deep spiritual significance. Bethel, where Jacob saw the ladder reaching to heaven, became a place to remember God's promises. Mount Sinai marked the giving of the covenant. Gilgal held twelve stones to remind generations of God's deliverance. Gethsemane reminds us of Jesus' obedience, and the empty tomb of His resurrection and victory over death.

These were not just locations—they were living memorials, spaces where heaven touched earth and God's faithfulness was made real.

As I stand in familiar places, I'm reminded that our memories, especially those connected to people and divine moments, are sacred. They shape who we are and remind us of who God has been. Whether it's a beach in Waikiki or a quiet church pew, God meets us in spaces where memory and presence intertwine.

This is Liz's first time to Hawaii, and together we are filling up the memory banks—whether it's soaking in the beauty, the joy, and the sense that even here, in this faraway place, God is near and still writing our story.

May we always take time to pause, reflect, and give thanks for the places we've been, the people we've loved, and the God who walks with us still.
