This Mother's Day, I pause to give thanks for the remarkable women who have shaped my life and continue to shape our world. I have been truly blessed to be led by strong women of faith in our family — from my praying grandmothers, faithful spiritual moms, courageous wife, and devoted aunties, to the fierce love and resilience of my female cousins. They have faced astronomical odds and overcome — not in their own strength, but in their unwavering service and devotion to God.

Their love has left an indelible mark on my life. I would not be who I am today without the nurturing, prayers, correction, discipline (ouch), wisdom, and faith-filled guidance of these incredible women. Through their lives, I have seen how generations are shaped — not by fame or status, but by consistent love and unshakeable faith.

We also remember the mothers who shaped our lives but are no longer with us. Their faith, love, prayers and legacy live on in our hearts and the lives they touched.
