From the Pastor's heart

A recent visit to Banff and Canmore offered breathtaking views of the mountains and their majestic surroundings. Standing in such beauty, I was reminded of how great our God is—the Creator of the universe who simply spoke these wonders into existence. As Isaiah 66:1 declares, "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool"—a powerful image of His greatness and sovereignty.


Yet, as awe-inspiring as these landscapes are, Scripture reminds us that we—humanity—are the crown glory of His creation (Is 62:3). That means we are loved, chosen, and deeply valued. God formed us with intention and purpose, not just as part of creation, but as bearers of His image. While the mountains declare His glory, our lives are meant to reflect His love. This truth gives me hope and purpose—not just to admire His creation, but to stand in awe that He created me to walk with Him.

Switching gears: I also want to share about our summer series, The Journey. This series focuses on personal ministry, taking a cue from Andrew, one of Jesus' disciples. Andrew didn't draw crowds—he brought individuals to Jesus. He invited his brother Peter, brought the boy with the loaves and fish, and even introduced Greeks to Jesus, reaching beyond cultural boundaries. His ministry was simple and personal.

This summer, we invite you to follow his example in three simple steps: **Pray**, **Invite**, and **Have Lunch**. Begin by praying for someone God places on your heart. Then invite them to join you for a Sabbath where we'll share a simple, Christ-centered message. Afterward, share a meal together and continue the conversation. With the whole summer ahead, there's plenty of time to choose a Sabbath that works for both of you. Let's walk this journey together, one personal invitation at a time.
