# From the Paston's heart

Throughout the school year, we have been studying the book of Ephesians, and we are in the final chapter. As we sit in the final chapter of Ephesians, I find myself truly grateful for the journey that we have taken through this powerful letter. Each week, we have explored what it means to live as followers of Jesus who are rooted in grace, built up in love, and called to walk worthy of the calling we have received.

"Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil." (Ephesians 6:10–11, NLT)

Now, as Paul closes his letter, he offers a final word of encouragement:

For many, this school year has felt like a battle. For others, this year has been filled with grief. For some, it has caused us to lean on God more than we ever have before. Some days are smooth and joyful, while some are marked by struggle and uncertainty. Whether your road was straight or winding, I want you to know that you have come a long way. I also want you to know that you are not in this fight alone.

This invitation from Paul is not to summon strength from within ourselves, but to be strong in the Lord. This will allow us to anchor our lives in His power and protection. We stand firm, not by might or by willpower, but by clothing ourselves in God's armour and trusting in the One who fights for us.

As you prepare for the coming week, I encourage you: When your mind feels like a battlefield, call on the name of the Lord.

When your focus slips and studying feels impossible, call on the name of the Lord. When your future feels uncertain and you're unsure of the next step, call on the name

of the Lord. Even when you're overwhelmed with joy, call on the name of the Lord. Let His name and His strength be your constant. Your refuge, your strength, and your

peace. May it be the sweetest name that you know. "The name of the Lord is a strong fortress; the godly run to him and are safe." (Proverbs 18:10). ~ from Pastor Dennalia's heart
