## From the Pastor's heart

Some school years begin smoothly, almost as if every detail of planning and preparation falls neatly into place. Those seasons feel rewarding because the effort poured in beforehand seems to pay off. But then there are other years—years that feel the complete opposite. No matter how much effort you put in, nothing goes the way you hoped. For me, this school year has started off in one of those rough ways. At times, it feels like I'm wandering through a maze, trying hard to take the right turns, to stay on track, and to keep from getting completely disoriented. Yet even with all that effort, there's still that sinking feeling that maybe I've already taken a wrong turn. Maybe I really am lost.

But in that thought, there's also a reminder of hope. The truth of the gospel is that God seeks us out because we are lost. Jesus came into the world to seek and to save those who wander, those who can't find their way, and those who feel overwhelmed or stuck. It doesn't matter whether we know we're lost, or whether we're too stubborn to admit it—we are never outside of His searching love. That promise gives me comfort: God is always looking for us, and He will not stop until He finds us. Luke 19:10 “For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”
