

From the Pastor's heart

Over the years, I have lived in seven different countries. Each move meant starting over in a place where I knew no one. My first experience away from home came at just 16 years old, when I left to pursue theology for my undergraduate degree in a country different from where I was raised.

I remember the questions swirling in my mind: Will I survive the food? Am I equipped for this? Will I make friends? With no clear answers, I went anyway. When I arrived, reality set in—sleeping on a thin three-inch foam mattress over plywood, showering in water barely filtered from a nearby pond, and fighting off endless mosquitoes. The food, language, and way of life were foreign to me, yet I clung to one thing: God's promise that He would be with me. I carried the prayers of my parents, grandmother, and family, who had placed me into God's hands.

There's a phrase from my culture that was spoken over me: "O ou māmā na"—translated, "those are your lungs." It meant that just as lungs are essential to breathe, this journey would be vital to my life. God's breath would sustain me through both highs and lows.
